After School Kids Program Fall 2018 / Winter and Spring 2019



This exciting art-making program for kids in grades 1-4 (ages 7-10) is held weekly at Anderson Ranch Arts Center in Snowmass Village. Workshops take place after school most Wednesday afternoons, October through April. Students express themselves creatively while learning, skill building and hands-on creating in these engaging workshops!

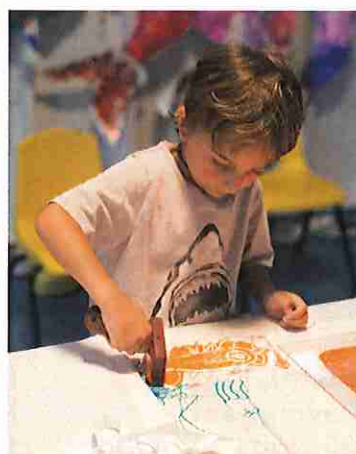
Young creators explore different themes each month in photography, printmaking, painting, woodworking, ceramics, sculpture, and digital fabrication, including 3D printing. Workshops also feature special visits from Anderson Ranch artists and tours of the Ranch studios.

## THE DETAILS:

## Session One- Printmaking Possibilities!

In October, we discover the amazing creative possibilities of printmaking! As an introduction we begin with foam plate prints, creating our own rubber stamps, and practice our carving skills on soft cut linoleum blocks. We familiarize ourselves with printing processes, different kinds of colorful inks, and a printer's tool set. As the session progresses we visit the Anderson Ranch Arts Center printmaking studio for live artist demonstrations and collaborative monoprints.

## Session Two- Adventures in Sculpture and Digital Fabrication

In November, we learn and think about the unique properties of sculpture. First, we take time to consider what sculpture can be and explore the fundamentals using wire, plaster, paper, and cardboard. Then we dive deeper into different sculptural processes using the Anderson Ranch Arts Center sculpture facilities. We get introduced to the world of 3D printers, plasma cutters, and laser printing! We learn about the exciting intersection between technology and art as we simultaneously create sculpture projects to take home.

## Session Three- Woodworking Wonders

In December, we explore the world of woodworking. We get our hands dirty as we practice designing, measuring, cutting, hammering, and sanding. We practice this unique set of skills as we build our very own picture frames and wooden boxes from start to finish. Students also visit the woodworking and woodturning studio for unique demonstrations using state-of-the-art equipment, including the CNC router. We use saws, hammers, nails, clamps and more as we learn the precision and skill it takes to work with wood.

## Session Four- Drawing and Painting

In February, we break out our paintbrushes and discover different kinds of painting. We use watercolors, acrylic and fabric paints to create one-of-a-kind masterpieces. We think about landscape, portraiture, and still-life painting techniques, as well as handy tricks to keep us creating. Join us as we hone our drawing skills first, then create paintings of all types and sizes! If time allows, we collaborate on a large-scale group mural that will hang in the children's building during summer workshops.

## Session Five- Photography and Digital Media

In March, we learn about photography and think about the different ways we can create lasting images. First we begin by considering light, composition, and how pictures capture the world around us. Students will be supplied with a digital point-and-shoot camera for daily photographic explorations. We also discover the possibilities of iPhone photography, Photoshop editing and fun applications to use on our photos. Prints of varying sizes will be available to take home along with decorated picture frames.

## Session Six- Crazy for Ceramics

Skill Level: Ages 7-10

In April, we learn how to build pots of all shapes and sizes out of clay! We begin by discovering different types of clay bodies, then practice hand building by making pinch pots, coil pots, and rolling slabs. We use molds and drapery techniques to create functional objects such as bowls, cups, and plates for our homes. We then discover different texture tools and glaze applications to make our pots one of a kind. Finally, we visit the Anderson Ranch kiln yard and ceramics studio to learn about different types of firing processes. If we have time we even try our hand at the potter's wheel!
